Please join us as we celebrate the 250th anniversary of the 42nd Royal Highlanders (The Black Watch), led by Capt. Thomas Sterling, take possession of Fort de Chartres from St. Ange and his company of French Marines. This event is very special because it is the final 250th celebration of the French and Indian War.

There is a \$10 registration fee per person to attend this event, children 12 and under are free. Upon arrival, you will be required to check-in at the registration booth, located in the pavilion by the visitor parking lot, to pick up your registration packet and get directions to your designated camping area. The registration packet will include an event medallion and keepsake booklet, a meal ticket for the catered dinner and dance Saturday evening, a site map, event schedule, and a local area map showing local attractions.





Please return this application by August 1st, 2015. Anyone registering after August 1st through August 31st will be required to pay a \$5 late fee per person.

Since this is a French and Indian War reenactment, we are restricting participant portrayal time-frame to 1740-1790.

Striking the Colors- 250th Guidelines

1. Registration Booth will be open at the following times:

Sunday, October 4th: 12:00pm-7:00pm Monday, Oct. 5th- Friday, Oct. 9th: 9:00am-7:00pm

- 2. All participants will be able to drive in to designated camping site to unload. Please move your vehicle to participant parking in a timely manner. We ask that you change into 18th century attire and remain in such during the duration of the event including evening hours.
- 3. The event runs from 10:00am-5:00pm daily.
- 4. Participants can drive into camp to pack up after 5:00pm on Sunday. Carts are available for early pack out.
- 5. Non-period items must be concealed and kept out of sight at all times.
- 6. Water and Firewood provided. The state of Illinois prohibits individuals from bringing firewood to state parks.
- 7. Please keep your pets at home.
- 8. There will be a \$25 trade fee for Merchants and a \$10 trade fee for blanket traders.
- 9. All items sold at the event shall be authentic to 1740-1790 time period.
- 10. No guns should be loaded in the camping areas, guns should only be loaded with blanks in demonstration areas.
